

2011 Bathurst Community Event Liquor Accord

Event name:

Supercheap Auto Bathurst 1000:

The Supercheap Auto Bathurst 1000 is a 1,000 kilometre touring car race held annually at the Mount Panorama Circuit in Bathurst. The race is traditionally run on the second Sunday in October. It is known amongst fans and broadcasters as “The Great Race”, and is widely regarded as the pinnacle of Australian motorsport. Since 2000 the race has been run exclusively for V8 Supercars and is now a round of the V8 Supercar Championship Series.

An estimated 180,000 spectators and visitors attend the 4 days of the event.

Event dates and Period of the Bathurst Community Event Liquor Accord:

The 2011 Supercheap Auto Bathurst 1000 will be held:

Thursday 6 October to Sunday 9 October inclusive.

The period of the Bathurst Community Event Liquor Accord will be:

10am Thursday 6 October to 6am Monday 10 October

Bathurst Community Event Liquor Accord conditions/measures:

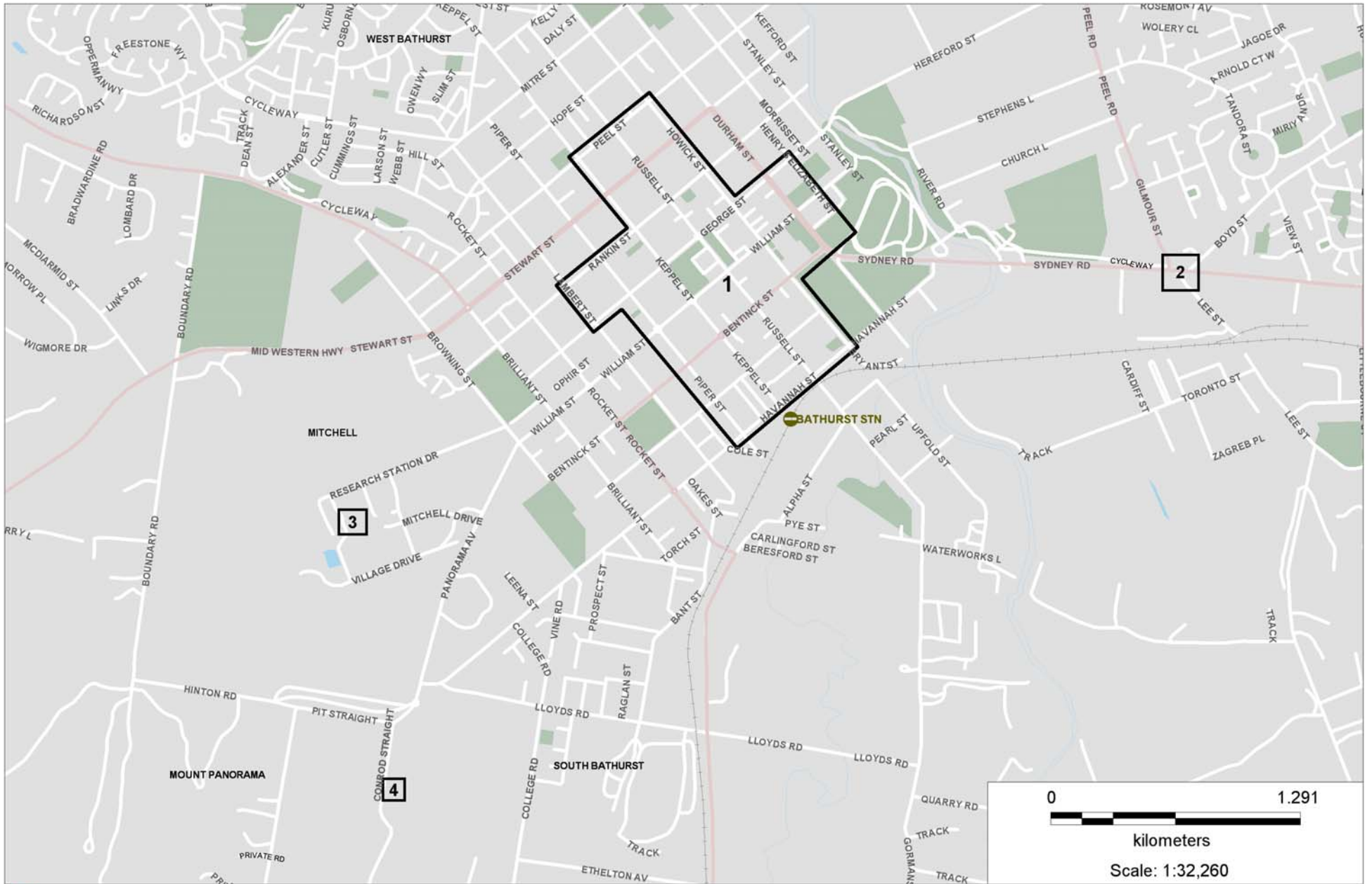
The following voluntary conditions/measures will apply for the period of the Bathurst Community Event Liquor Accord:

- A lockout will exist for all licensed venues from 1am
- A regime of “staggered closing times” will be implemented. Late trading venues have nominated a voluntary “trade no later than” time. Clubs will commence closing from 12 midnight. Licensed premises will cease to serve alcohol consecutively at 1am; 2am; 3am and 3.30am
- Venue closures will be conducted in conjunction with available Police resources 30 minutes after the cessation of the service of alcohol at each venue

- The last venue will close at 4am
- The Bathurst Liquor Accord and local and regional licensing Police will agree on indicative “no later than” closing times for each late trading venue by 3pm each day of the accord period, and protocols to communicate and confirm times (please see attached template)
- Plastic drinking vessels will be available to be used in licensed venues at the discretion of Licensees and in consultation with Police

Other activities to support the Bathurst Community Event Liquor Accord

- OLGR Compliance officers to conduct Responsible Service of Alcohol courses for the staff of Bathurst licensed venues staff prior to the event
- OLGR will supply collateral to support and promote in a consistent manner, the messages and details of the Bathurst Community Event Liquor Accord
- A late night Bathurst Town and Mount Panorama community shuttle bus service organised by the Bathurst Regional Council, will operate with the service extended until 4.30am on the Saturday and Sunday mornings
- Security will be deployed on all shuttle buses operating after midnight

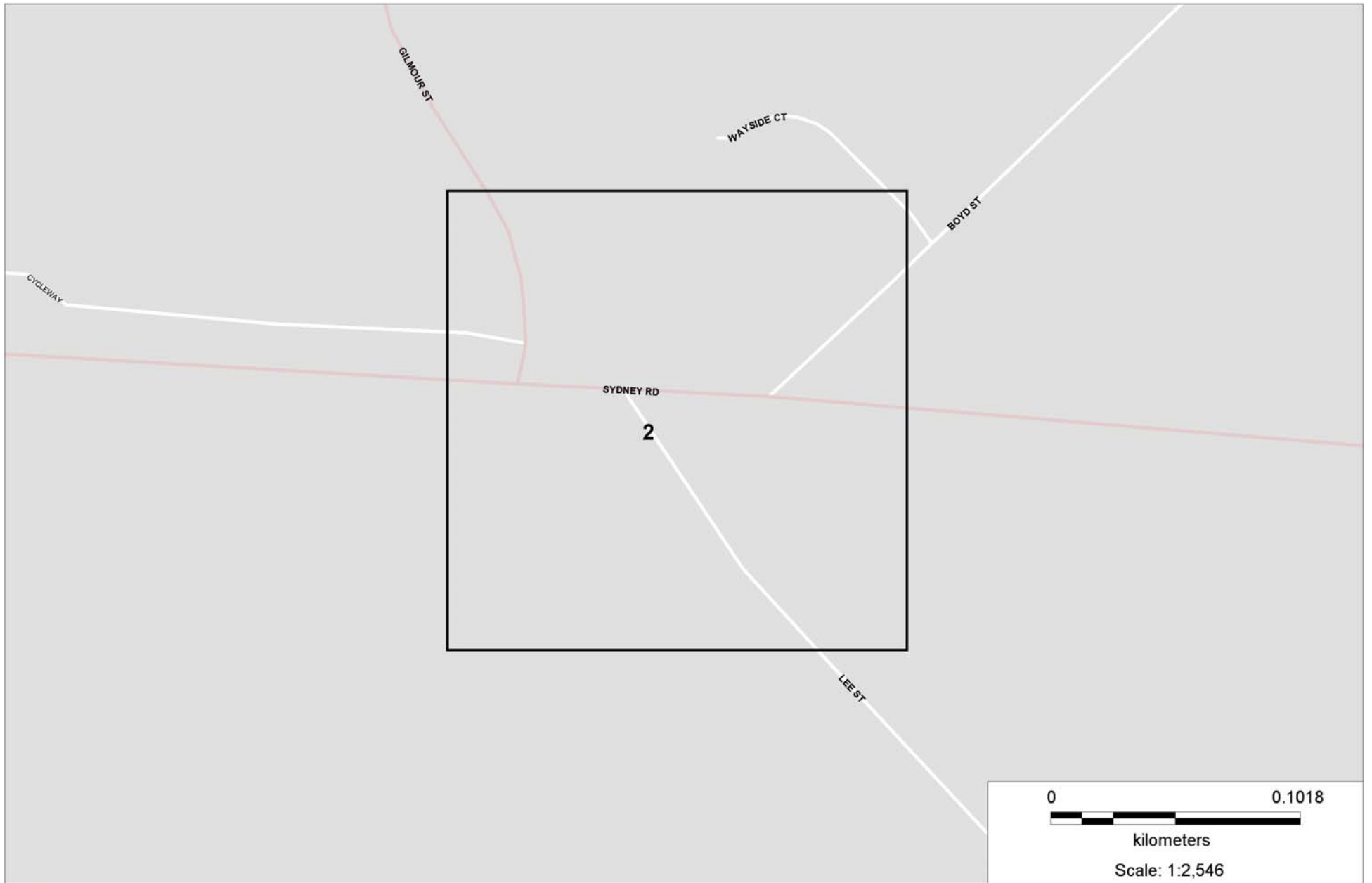




 Community Event Liquor Accord Boundary (area 1)

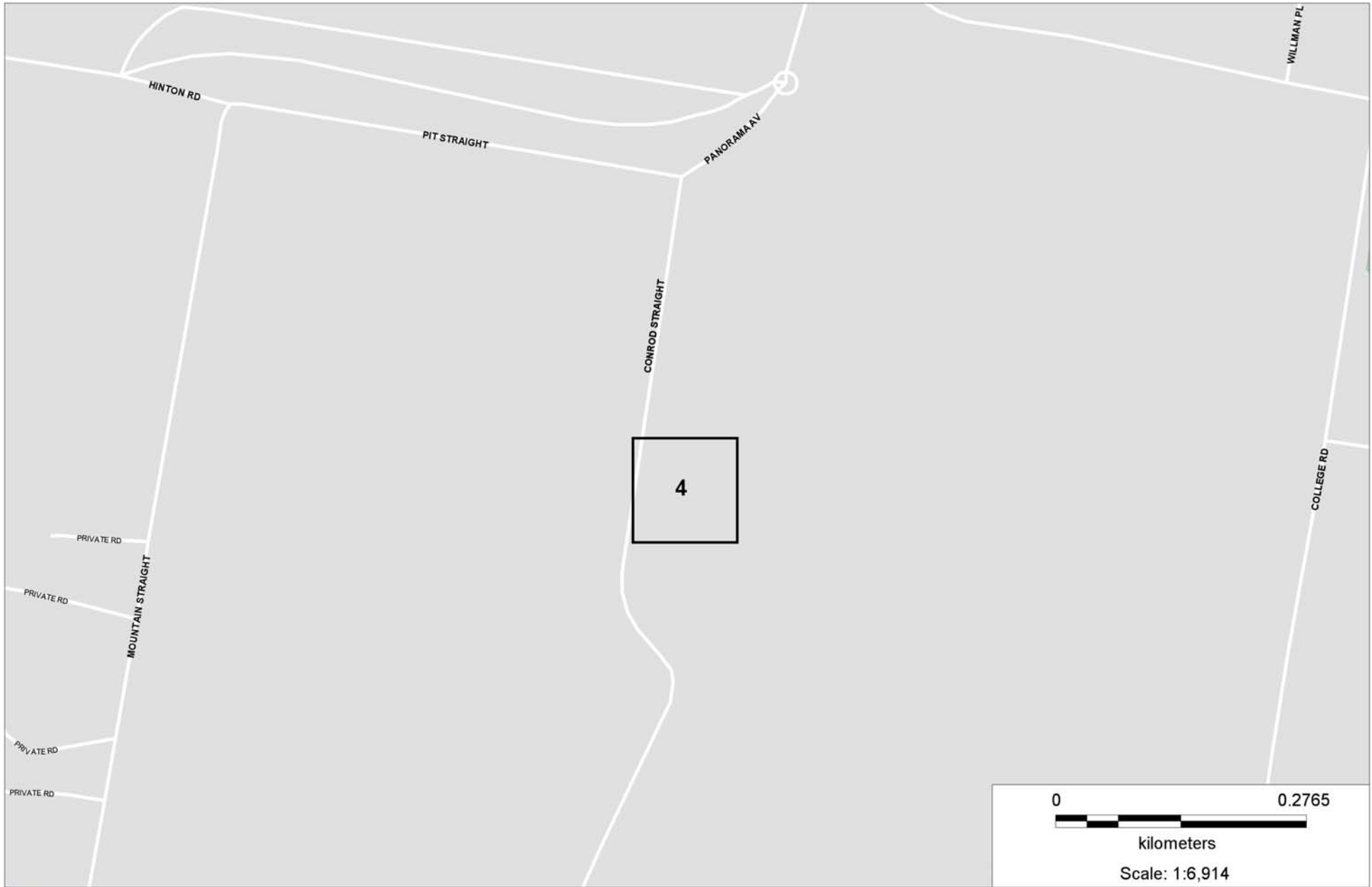
