

Minimum Viable Product Grants



What are Minimum Viable Product grants?

Minimum Viable Product (MVP) grants support promising pre-revenue startup businesses across all industry sectors to progress from Proof of Concept to a Minimum Viable Product stage of development.

What funding is available?

A matched funding grant up to 50% of approved total development costs is available to NSW startups, to a maximum of \$25,000. Successful applicants will receive 35% of the funding initially and 65% after completion and validation of the MVP.

Who is eligible?

To be eligible for an MVP grant, a startup business must:

- Have a completed proof of concept
- Have an ABN registered in NSW and be based in NSW
- Be at pre-revenue stage
- Hold IP or the rights to commercialise
- Have a potential business customer or business channel to market
- Have a scalable solution that can be deployed to multiple customers
- Demonstrate 80% of development costs will occur in NSW
- Demonstrate matched funding has been secured for the project



How do I apply?

Applications are open all year round. For more details, please visit jobsforNSW.com.au

Your startup business must meet the MVP grant eligibility requirements. If your business has generated revenue and is starting to scale, you may be eligible for other assistance from Jobs for NSW.

All applications are assessed competitively against the MVP Assessment Criteria.
