



Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

The Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct will have education at its heart, while also connecting students to training and employment opportunities, with local industry, and the surrounding community. It will be an open, safe place where locals can access shared facilities and new community spaces.

The Preliminary Masterplan for the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct identified potential ways to create a highly connected Precinct including potential infrastructure such as public and active transport options. Investigation work in your area

As part of the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct, preliminary ground investigation work will be undertaken in the rail corridor north of Meadowbank Station and on adjacent streets on the **western side of the station**. These investigations will include:

- **From 8am to 5pm Thursday 23 July** - test pits along Bank Street and service investigation work outside the rail corridor
- **From 8am to 5pm Friday 24 July** - boreholes in Wool Way reserve on the corner of Bank Street and Union Street
- **From 6am to 6pm Saturday 25 July and Sunday 26 July** - boreholes and test pits in the rail corridor

In addition to the work above, topographic surveying will also be undertaken during this period. Equipment that will be used include drilling rigs, excavators, vacuum trucks, and tripods for surveying. This preliminary investigation work will provide information to help inform the planning and design of the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct.

Changes to parking

On Thursday 23 July and Friday 24 July, approximately two parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable on Bank Street, between Constitution Road West and Union Street. There will also be short footpath closures on Bank Street to allow for machinery to access worksites. Pedestrian control will be in place to help pedestrians with these temporary changes.
