

Schools at the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct

Works notification

Removal of material from site

A project is underway to relocate Meadowbank Public School and Marsden High School to the Meadowbank Education and Employment Precinct, following the construction of new facilities.

The planned remediation works will require the removal of material from site, which contain lead, benzo(a)pyrene, bonded asbestos (attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure) and non-bonded asbestos (has the potential to become airborne).

Safety measures have been put in place to ensure there is no risk to the local community. The area has been secured, and appropriate control and monitoring measures will be installed during the remediation work.

The material will be removed by a licensed and accredited removal contractor, and is scheduled to take place from Wednesday 17 June between 7:00am and 5:00pm on weekdays and between 8:00am and 1:00pm on Saturday, weather permitting. The work is expected to take seven weeks.

The works will be conducted in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW requirements and testing will be completed after the work to ensure the site has been fully remediated. A clearance certificate will be issued by a consultant hygienist in order for work on the project to continue.

The health, safety and well-being of the community and local residents is our highest priority. Please be assured that the removal of this material will not pose a risk to the community.
