Regional Job Precincts Factsheet

The NSW Government's Regional Job Precincts will provide planning support to help fast-track approvals to drive growth, investment and development opportunities within regional NSW.

WHAT IS THE GOAL OF REGIONAL JOB PRECINCTS?

Regional Job Precincts aim to tailor planning reform to support regional economic development and engine industries to create jobs in regional NSW.

WHERE WILL THE REGIONAL JOB PRECINCTS INITIATIVE RUN?

Locations for the initial round of Regional Job Precincts will cover a diverse range of locations and regional investment opportunities.

Locations are selected based on site suitability and potential to deliver economic benefits to their regions. Locations will be updated and published at nsw.gov.au/regionaljobprecincts as they are announced.

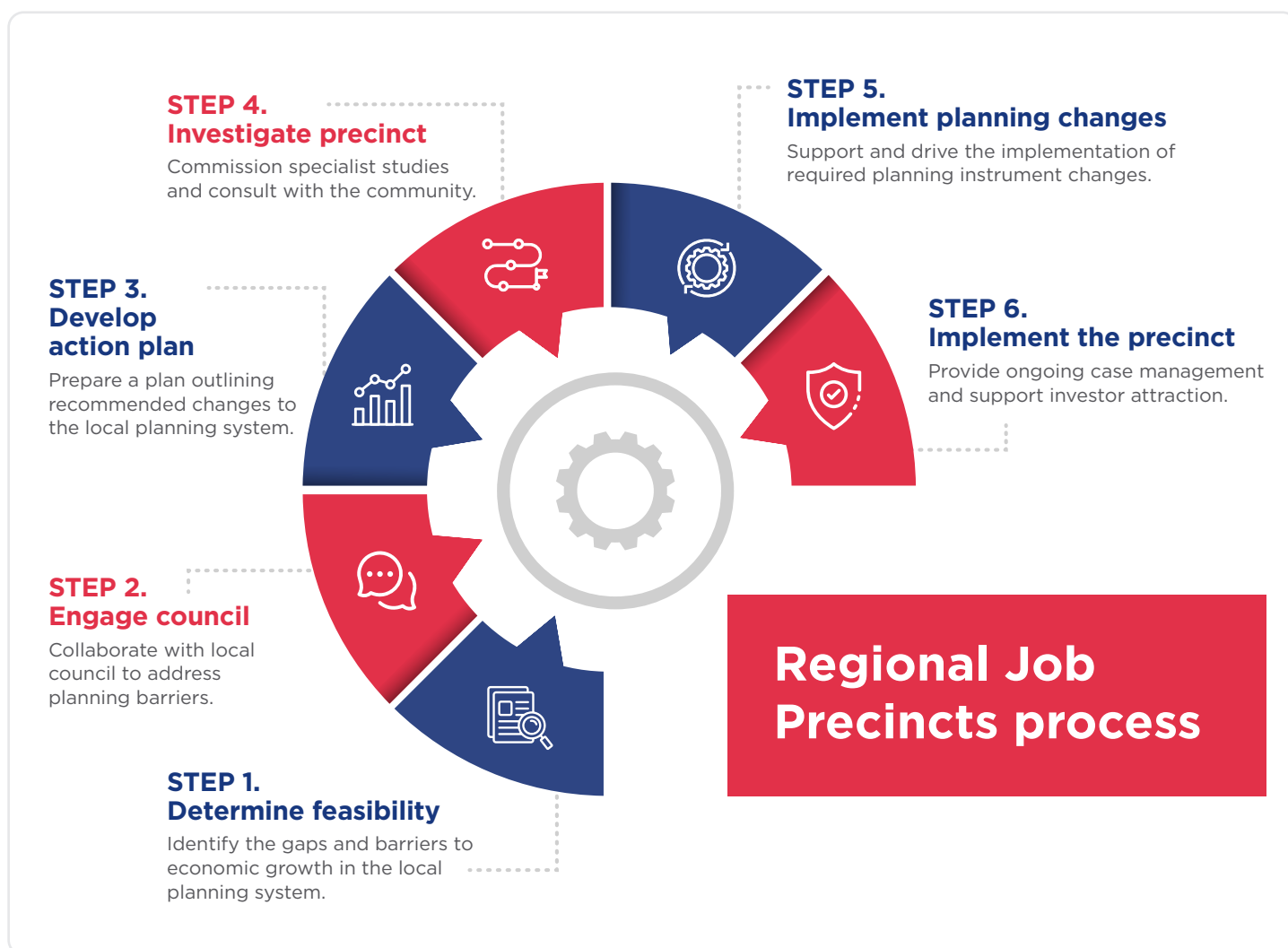
HOW WILL THE REGIONAL JOB PRECINCTS INITIATIVE WORK?

The NSW Government has commenced the first round of the Regional Job Precincts initiative, an extension of the Special Activation program that assists in the development of technical studies and provide planning support.

The NSW Government will engage specialist planning consultants who will work closely with the relevant local councils, businesses and communities to provide expert advice and identify ways to improve local planning processes and progress existing development opportunities in the region.

A flexible approach will be applied to each location tailored to the needs of each region.

Regional Job Precincts will follow a flexible six step process, as follows:



WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS TO THE COMMUNITY?

The NSW Government will work directly with local councils and communities to improve local planning processes to unlock investment and growth opportunities for regional economies, delivering stability and creating jobs.

Regional Job Precincts are part of the NSW Government's commitment to support regional communities and accelerate economic growth in regional NSW.

HOW CAN COMMUNITIES GET INVOLVED?

Community members in the Regional Job Precinct locations will have the opportunity to provide feedback throughout the development of the precincts. Updates on upcoming community engagement opportunities will be communicated across local council and NSW Government communication channels.

HOW LONG WILL THE REGIONAL JOB PRECINCTS INITIATIVE RUN?

The initial round of Regional Job Precincts is scheduled for completion in late-2021.

ARE THERE OPPORTUNITIES FOR OTHER COMMUNITIES TO GET A REGIONAL JOB PRECINCT?

Opportunities for potential future rounds of precincts will be considered upon completion of Round 1.
