3. Registration Concession Type (select appropriate)

Ambulance Vehicle (AMBU)

Light or heavy vehicle other than a government owned vehicle, specially constructed and solely used for carrying sick or injured persons. Concession does not entitle an operator to fit flashing lights and sirens. Only vehicles used solely by the Ambulance Service of NSW as defined under the *Health Services Act 1997* or a vehicle delegated by the Ambulance Service of NSW under their delegated authority may be fitted with flashing lights and sirens.

Civil Defence Vehicle (CIVL) / State Emergency Service (SES)

Light or heavy vehicle used by a civil defence group, an industrial mutual aid group or a rescue organisation solely in connection with civil defence or rescue work arising from some general emergency or catastrophe such as drought, flood, fire or similar emergency. Vehicles must be registered in the name of the organisation controlling the work. Vehicles registered to government agencies, other than councils are not eligible.

Rural Lands Protection Board Vehicle (PAST)

Light truck or trailer used solely for the functions of Local Land Services.

Police Youth Club Vehicle (POLC)

Light vehicle owned by a Police Youth Club and used solely for Police Youth purposes.

Transport for people with a disability (HAND)

Light or heavy passenger vehicle used solely for the work of conveying sick or injured (including intellectually or mobility impaired) people.

- Vehicles used for private use are not eligible
- Vehicles registered to government agencies are not eligible.
- Goods vehicles are not eligible, for example utilities and trucks.

Primary Producer Vehicle (PPG)

A **light vehicle** that is owned by a primary producer or rural society and while on a road or road related area, is either solely or principally to:

- cart primary products the primary producer or another primary producer has produced
- cart leaves gathered by the primary producer or another primary producer and from which eucalyptus or other oil is to be distilled
- cart goods of any kind for the primary producer or another primary producer's business or household
- clear land the primary producer or another primary producer proposes to use for primary production.

OR

A **heavy vehicle** that is owned by a primary producer or rural society and while on a road or road related area, is used solely to:

- cart primary products the primary producer or another primary producer has produced
- cart leaves gathered by the primary producer or another primary producer and from which eucalyptus or other oil is to be distilled
- cart goods of any kind for the primary producer or another primary producer's business
- clear land the primary producer or another primary producer proposes to use for primary production.

Fish farmers and plantation forest cultivators are primary producers. Commercial fishers and loggers are not primary producers under this legislation and are therefore not entitled to a primary producer registration concession

A vehicle does not qualify for this concession if it is hired or let to another person, or if it is used by any person other than the registered operator for any sort of fee or consideration (reward).

You must provide one of the following documents to support your application:

- A declaration signed by a registered tax agent or accountant, stating the applicant is a primary producer as defined under the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2017 (which is not more than 12 months old), or
- A Tax Averaging Certificate from the Australian Taxation Office (not more than two years old), or
- A Tax Assessment Notice from the Australian Taxation Office (not more than two years old).

Roadwork by a Council, Park or Cemetery Trust (RDWK)

Light vehicle owned by a Council, Park or Cemetery Trust and used solely for or in accordance with the:

- construction, maintenance or repair of roads, bridges or cemeteries including supervising such work; or
- removal of garbage or night soil; or
- rolling or maintenance of tennis courts, cricket pitches, lawns or pathways; or
- improving the surface of the ground or similar work and is not let for hire.

Roadwork General (RDWK)

Light vehicle used solely for:

- the construction, maintenance or repair of roads or bridges; or
- removal of garbage or night soil; and is
- a self-propelled plant;
- a roadwork plant trailer; or
- a trailer used to carry roadwork plant.

School Student Driver Education Vehicle (SCHL)

Light vehicle used solely or principally by a Government school or a registered non-Government school for the purpose of driver education of students.

Surf Life Saving Club Vehicle (SURF)

Light or heavy vehicle used on road or road related areas solely to transport surf rescue boats.

Tow Trucks with 'Crane and Hook' Body (TOW)

Light vehicle constructed to Partially lift and tow other vehicles, but not carry other vehicles, and the vehicle will be garaged in: *(please tick the appropriate Transport District)*

- Sydney
- Newcastle
- Wollongong
- Other Transport District

Wheelchair Modified Vehicle (PRIV, with vehicle condition code V88)

Light vehicle used substantially for private purposes and modified to allow wheelchair access and to transport them safely and securely (eg hoists, anchor points, additional doors etc). A compliance certificate issued by a licenced certifier on Transport for NSW's Vehicle Safety Compliance Certification Scheme is also required.

Fire Fighting Vehicle (not Fire and Rescue NSW) (FIRE)

- Council-owned light vehicle - used for bush fire control, and may also be used for road maintenance repair and construction, but not for any other purpose.
- Company-owned light vehicle - used solely for and in connection with the control of bush fires.

Mobile Crane (MCRA)

Light mobile crane not let for hire.

Mine Rescue Vehicle (MINE)

Light or heavy vehicle used solely for mine rescue work in accordance with the *Coal Industry Act 2001*.

4. Customer / Organisation Declaration

You declare:

- you are eligible for the concession
- you will notify us within 14 days if your concession eligibility ceases
- you understand the need to provide evidence of your concession eligibility when requested. If the evidence is not provided it can lead to you paying vehicle registration charges and tax
- you understand Transport for NSW can suspend or cancel the vehicle registration for concession ineligibility

Under road transport legislation, it is an offence to attempt to register or renew the registration of a vehicle by false statement or any misrepresentation or other dishonest means.
