

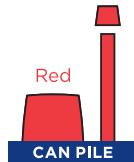
SAFE BOATING – NAVIGATION MARKS

CHANNEL MARKERS

Generally used for well defined channels, they indicate the port and starboard hand sides of the route to be followed when going upstream.

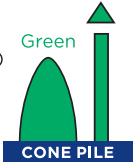
Port Hand Markers

Keep these marks on your port (left) side when going **upstream**. Light when fitted is RED.



Starboard Hand Markers

Keep these marks on your starboard (right) side when going **upstream**. Light when fitted is GREEN.



ISOLATED DANGER MARKS

Indicate the danger with navigable water all around them.

Two black spheres – Pass either side – but at a safe distance.



LIGHT WHEN FITTED WHITE TWO FLASHES

SAFE WATER MARKS

Show navigable water all around. May indicate centre line or mid-channel.

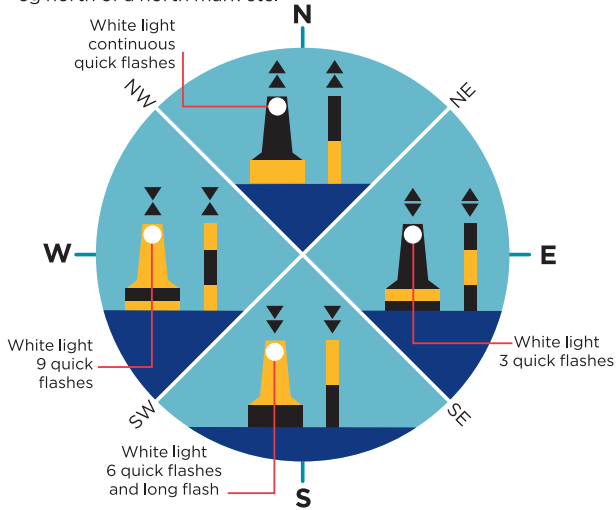
Red sphere – RED/WHITE vertical stripes. Pass either side.



LIGHT WHEN FITTED WHITE ONE FLASH

CARDINAL MARKS

Take their name from the compass quadrant in which they are placed and indicate the safe side of a danger on which to pass, eg north of a north mark etc.
