BEFORE BOATING
Check the weather; check the boat and its gear; tell someone where you are going.

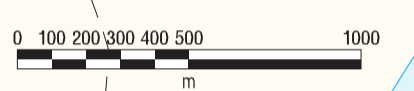
HYPOTHERMIA

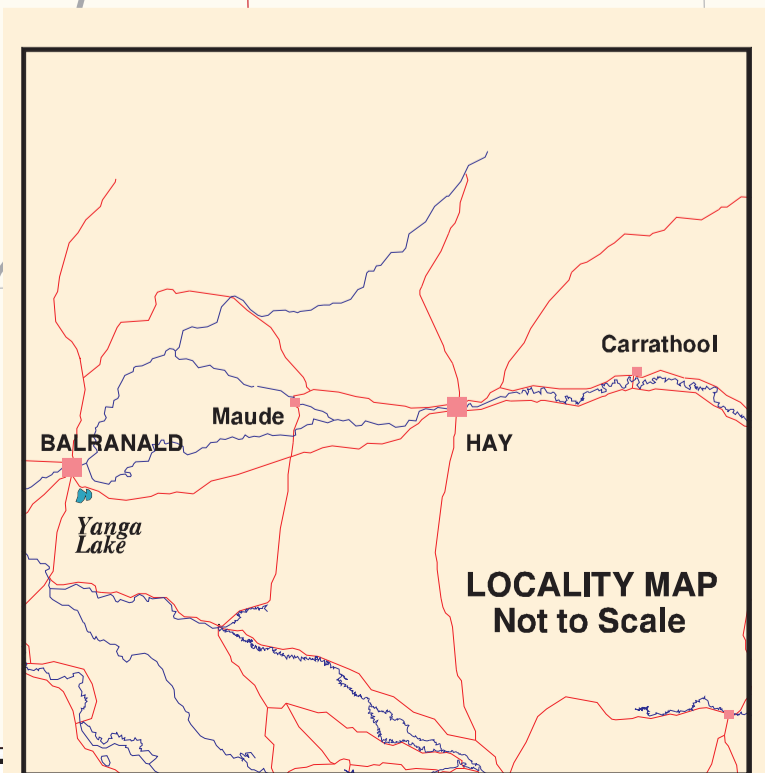
