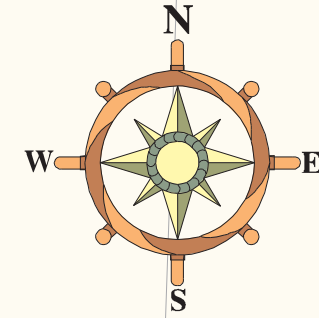

**THE NATIONAL PARKS AND WILDLIFE CODE**

- \* Guard against all risks of fire.

**Navigation Hazards:** Caution should be exercised when navigating in the Nepean River. Keep a lookout for logs and other floating debris, particularly after rain periods.

**CAUTION:** Navigation in the Nepean River can be congested. Please observe speed and wash restrictions and keep to starboard (right hand side) when passing oncoming craft.

Note: All navigable waters south of Eureka Creek are an 8 Knot Zone.
