## Electric, hybrid and hydrogen vehicles safety labels

December 2021

Safety labels help emergency services follow safety procedures if an electric, hybrid or hydrogen vehicle is in a crash.

Light vehicle





Heavy vehicle



Motorcycle



Labels must be attached to **all** number plates on:

- electric, hybrid and hydrogen light vehicles
- electric, hybrid and hydrogen heavy vehicles modified or manufactured after 1 January 2019.

Hydrogen vehicles

The labels **must** be clearly visible at all times. From 1 January 2022 penalties, including a defect notice and/or fine, apply to the operator or driver of vehicles that don't comply.

## Replacement labels

Free replacement labels are available from any Service NSW Centre. You can also get them from your mechanic or motor dealer.

## How to attach

- Remove the backing from the label. This will help hold it in place while you take the next steps.
- Attach in an upright position on the number plate (not on the frame or cover).
- Don't obscure any characters or the state of issue.
- Fix into place so it's secure.
