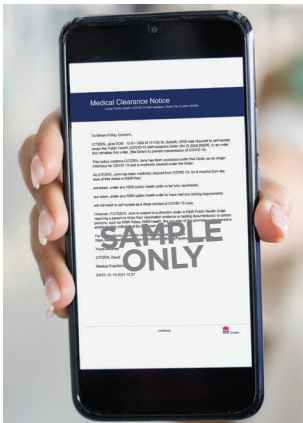


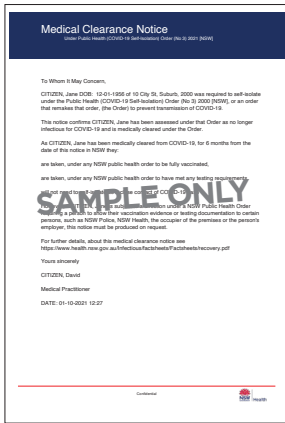
Proof of medical exemption

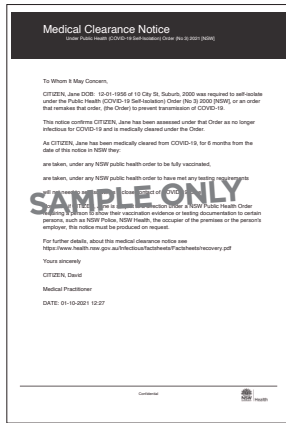
COVID-19 medical clearance notice

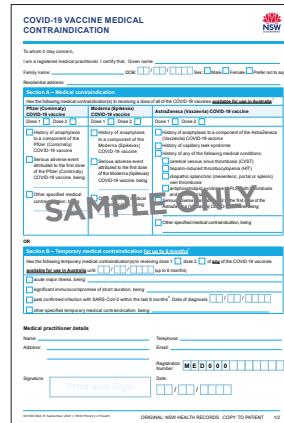

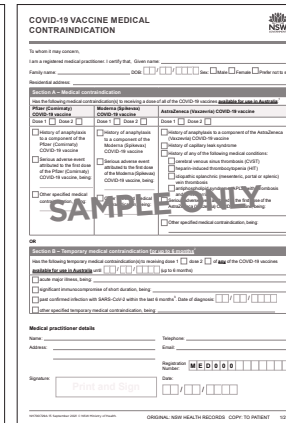

COVID-19 medical exemption form

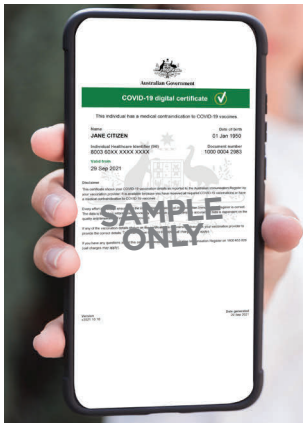

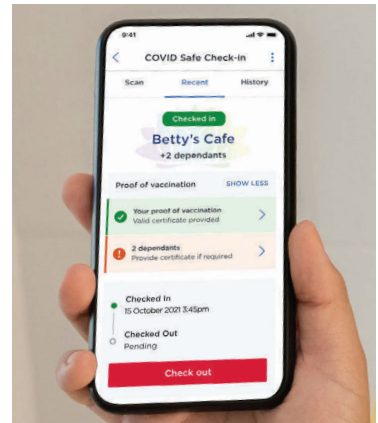

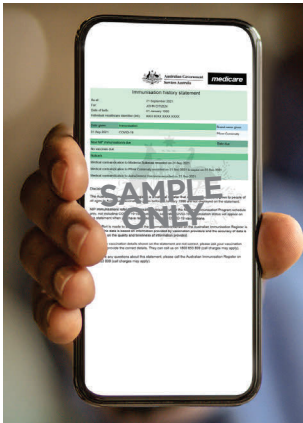

Certificate validation

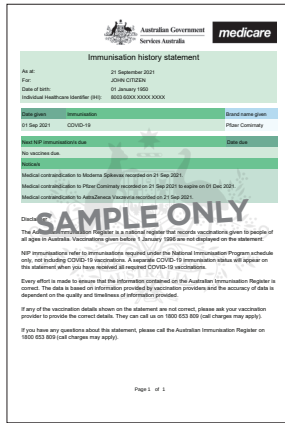

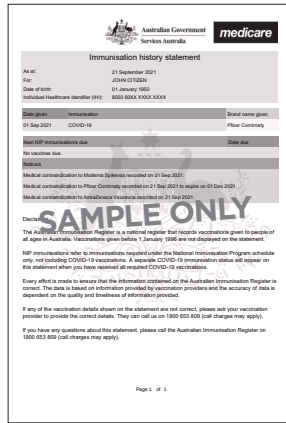
Immunisation history statement - medical exemption
