Paddle safe

Wear a lifejacket

• At all times day and night



Be prepared

- · Know the rules
- Check the weather and tides
- Carry ID and tell someone where you're going
- Check your canoe or kayak and safety equipment



Be aware

- Keep a proper lookout, including behind you
- · Look out for larger vessels
- Watch out for vessel wash



Keep safe, stay right

- Avoid paddling in the centre of a channel or river
- Cross behind larger vessels, not in front



Be bright, be seen

- · Wear highly visible clothing
- · Paddle in a group where possible
- Display an all-round white light and take extra care at night
