#### Glossary

- **People experiencing street homelessness**
  - People living in improvised dwellings, tents or sleeping out.
  - It **Includes** people who are street sleeping, people sleeping in cars, tents or makeshift structures
  - It **Excludes** people staying in supported or temporary accommodation, couch surfing

#### Data information

The current data source is the ABS Census which is available only every five years. In order to monitor progress towards target between Census dates, the NSW Government will conduct a state-wide street count annually from February 2020.
