

Parkes Special Activation Precinct – Early work

Special Activation Precincts are dedicated business hubs in regional NSW, designed to create jobs, attract investment and fuel economic growth.

The Parkes Special Activation Precinct is the new epicentre of the nation's freight network.

Regional Growth NSW Development Corporation has engaged Fulton Hogan to design and build Stage 1 of the Parkes Special Activation Precinct.

Fulton Hogan began survey and geotechnical investigations within the precinct in early May. This work will continue for about five weeks, weather permitting. The information from these investigations will be used to finalise detailed design of the Parkes precinct.

Early work activities

From June, the following activities will start on site:

- Establishing site compounds and storage areas
- Installing temporary fencing around work areas
- Removing minor vegetation within the project alignment
- Utility investigations, ground survey and potholing
- Setting up dust measuring monitors and sediment control fencing

Major construction work will start in October with the project expected to be complete in mid-2023.

How will work affect you?

Work will be carried out between **7am and 6pm Mondays to Fridays** and **8am and 1pm Saturdays**, weather permitting. There may be some work required at night in some locations to reduce impacts on traffic flow. Nearby residents and the community will be notified in advance of this work.

Traffic changes

At times there may be some temporary traffic changes to ensure work areas are safe. Please keep to the sign posted speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
