Trade Pathways

Implementing the NSW Productivity Commission recommendation to:

- build pathways to trade qualification
- increase the representation of women, mature age workers and school leavers in trades.

These are actioned via four streams:



Fund Overview

Trade Pathways Innovation Fund

- Industry-led innovation
- Focused on trade (and trade-like) qualifications / occupations
- \$5 million funding allocation
- Up to \$500,000 per project
- Delivery across one or more Training Services NSW regions
- •12-month duration with commencement in May 2023

One application per organisation. Nominate as a delivery partner across multiple applications.



Fund Objectives

Trade Pathways Innovation Fund

Category A - Establish new pathways to trade qualification

Category B - Enhance existing non-traditional pathways to trade qualification





Project scope

Projects are to:

- Improve accessibility of trade training
- Contribute towards an uplift in trade qualification attainment
- Be fully funded
- Nominate focus occupation/s and qualification/s
- Be evidence-based
- Have broad support in the relevant industry
- Have strong engagement with stakeholders and partners





Out of Scope

Trade Pathways Innovation Fund

- Traditional pathways to trade such as apprenticeships and traineeships
- Trade 'tasters'
- Pre-apprenticeship projects
- Proposals that do not have the ongoing support of industry





Fund eligibility criteria

Eligible applicants include:

- Industry representative bodies
- Industry Training Advisory Bodies (ITABs)
- Group Training Organisations or the peak body
- Local Government partnerships or peak bodies
- Trade Unions
- Skills Service Organisations





Participant eligibility

Trade Pathways Innovation Fund

Learners participating in accredited training project components must be

- 15 years or older at the time of enrolment
- No longer at enrolled school
- Living or working in NSW
- Australian Citizens, permanent residents, humanitarian visa holders or NZ citizens.










Up to \$500,000 per project proposal.

Grants will be paid in three stages:

• 50% at project commencement

• 30% at project mid-point







Assessment criteria

Applicants must address the four assessment criteria

Criteria 1 Project plan - Objective (A or B) - Focus occupation/s & qualification/s - Aims, activities, outputs, mileston es, timeline & outcome measures	Criteria 2 Engagement plan - Stakeholder & partner engagement approach - Communication strategy - Marketing approach	Criteria 3 Capability & capacity - Role, function & specialisation - Project delivery experience - Key staff experience & qualifications - Risk management	Criteria 4 Value for money - Social, economic & environmental benefits - Grant amount - Project budget
Weighting 40%	Weighting 20%	Weighting 20%	Weighting 20%
