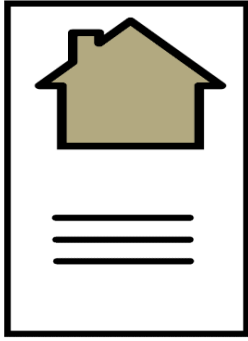




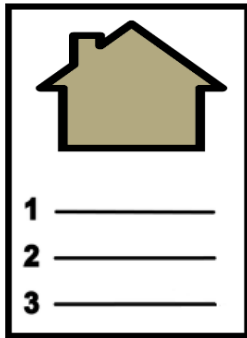

These are some things we think about.

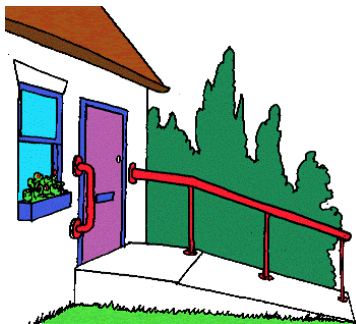


You are old.

Or

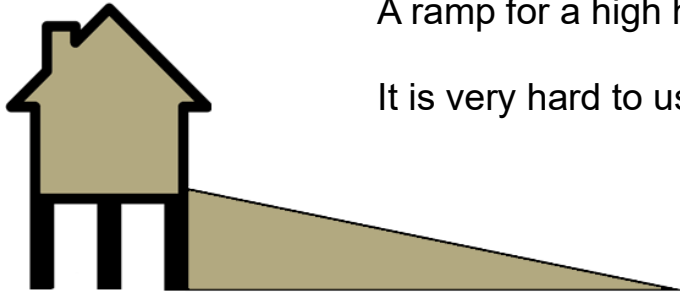


You have a disability.

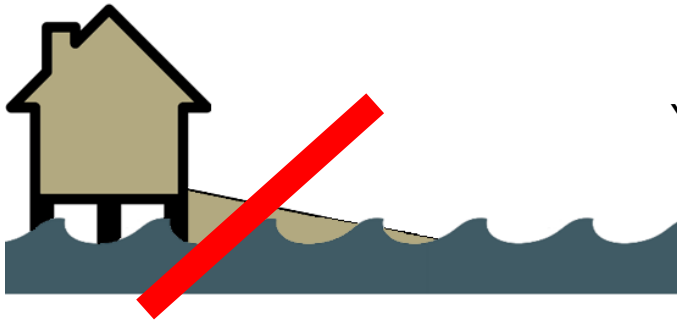


You have things to help you.

You are sick. You stay in bed a lot.



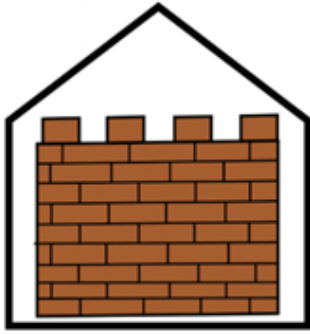
There is a flood.



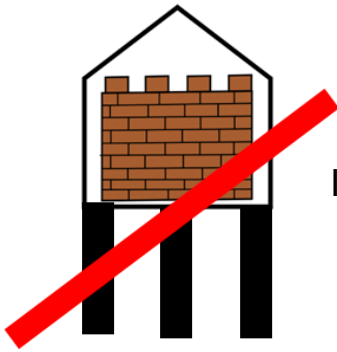
You need help to leave.



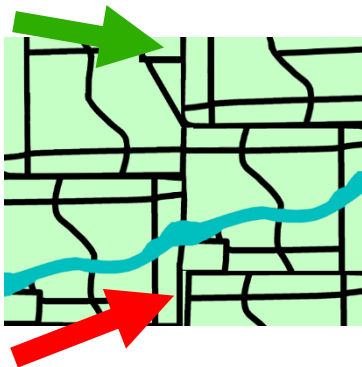
You need a different plan.

You can **not** live there.

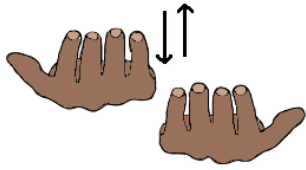


You take the rubbish away.



You need a new home.



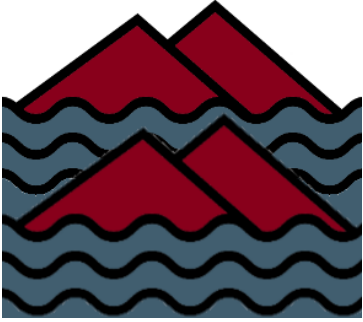

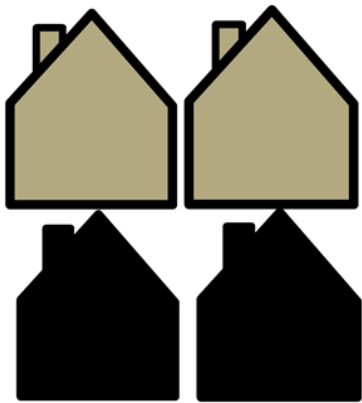

Other things we may look at

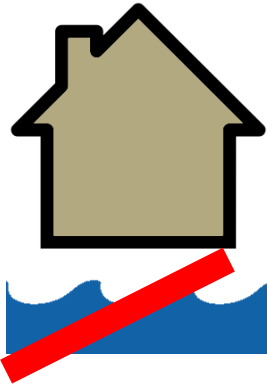


You live near the river.

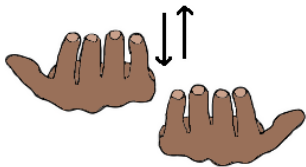
