

Create NSW Arts & Cultural Funding Program - 22/23 Regional Arts Touring Round 2 Successful Recipients

Total projects funded (10) at \$639,999

Accessible Arts, Accessible Arts' 2024 tour of 'Are You Pulling My Leg?' (\$16,211)

A regional tour of accessible comedy show, 'ARE YOU PULLING MY LEG?' showcases some of Australia's funniest comedians with disability to venues across NSW. This project increases visibility of artists with disability utilising the wide appeal of comedy and upskills venues through disability confidence training.

Arts on Tour NSW Ltd, 2024 NSW regional tour of THE VISITORS by Jane Harrison (\$82,551)

An 8-venue NSW regional tour of THE VISITORS in 2024, with a projected NSW audience of 2,760, as part of a national tour coordinated by Arts on Tour. Produced by Moogahlin Performing Arts and Sydney Theatre Company, this new production of Jane Harrison's impactful play is directed by Wesley Enoch.

Artspace Visual Arts Centre Ltd, Artspace presents Jonathan Jones regional tour 'untitled (transcriptions of country)' (\$90,000)

Artspace presents Wiradjuri/Kamilaroi artist Jonathan Jones's solo commission 'untitled (transcriptions of country)' as a regional tour. Jones and collaborating artists have created a monumental picture of Country, exploring the colonial translation of Australian native plants and Aboriginal portraits, music and knowledges during the 1800–03 voyage of Captain Nicolas Baudin.

CDP Theatre Producers Pty Ltd, "Dog Man The Musical" Regional NSW Touring Seasons (\$62,038)

CDP is proposing a tour of our new production of 'Dog Man The Musical' for children aged 6+, their families and education audiences, based on the much loved Dav Pilkey books, and is seeking funding to tour to 5 Regional NSW destinations as part of a 17 venue national tour.

Erth Visual & Physical Incorporated, Erth's regional 2024 tour of ARC (\$84,388)

ARC is a lyrically evocative work that challenges young audiences to address themes of grief, loss and ecological conservation. Touring 27 venues with an anticipated audience reach of 27,500, ARC is a powerfully important new work that will reaffirm the company's identity as a leader in high calibre children's theatre.

Lingua Franca, 2024 NSW tour of Highway of Lost Hearts (\$88,951)

6-venue NSW regional tour of Highway of Lost Hearts as part of a national tour, with projected NSW audience of 2760. With a team of entirely regional NSW artists, Bathurst's Lingua Franca takes a treasured Australian play, infusing it with original, live country music in an authentically Australian regional work.

Marrugeku Inc, Marrugeku's Regional NSW Burrbgaja Yalirra 2 Community Dance Workshop Tour (\$35,906)

To present a tailored community dance workshop program to four regional NSW communities to complement the Create NSW funded tour of Burrbgaja Yalirra 2 [Dancing Forwards] Triple Bill and showcase Marrugeku's practice of using local cultural stories to express movement and dance aiming to facilitate local dance practice and storytelling.

Monkey Baa Theatre for Young People Ltd, 10-venue NSW tour of Monkey Baa's The Peasant Prince 2024 (\$95,676)

The Peasant Prince will tour to 10 communities with 33 performances and 66 workshops. 6 Regional NSW communities, 2 in Western Sydney, 1 in Metro Sydney and Wollongong. Projected audience reach is 11,800 young people and families, 6,400 of whom are living in regional NSW.

Percussion Australia Ltd, Percussion Australia NSW Regional Touring for Taikoz (\$25,253)

Taikoz will tour their work Side By Side to Dubbo, Albury, Swan Hill, Grafton, Armidale, and Port Macquarie.

Riverside's National Theatre of Parramatta, GUARDS AT THE TAJ (National Theatre of Parramatta) (\$59,025)

Written by Rajiv Joseph, Guards at the Taj will tour to 7 communities in NSW. With a projected NSW audience of 5459, the NSW portion of the tour is part of a broader national tour across VIC, ACT and NT with a projected audience of over 8000.
