Testing and commissioning activities are progressing on Parramatta Light Rail as the project moves towards the commencement of passenger services.

Parramatta Light Rail is one of the NSW Government's latest major infrastructure projects being delivered to serve a growing Sydney. Parramatta Light Rail will connect Westmead to Carlingford via the Parramatta CBD and Camellia. The final stage of testing and commissioning and driver training is underway. This means light rail vehicles are running in both directions between Westmead and Carlingford, seven days a week.

Installation of signage

From Wednesday 23 October 2024, Transport for NSW will carry out works to install new signage at current 'No stopping' and 'No parking' zones on roads along the Parramatta Light Rail alignment. This work will generally happen at night under traffic control.

Tow away areas

It is important to know that roads along the Parramatta Light Rail alignment with current 'No stopping' and 'No parking' zones, will see special tow away areas come into effect from **Wednesday 23 October 2024**, to support operations.

Please check roadside signage before you park.

Roads affected

Tow away signage will be installed on each side of the following roads and streets.

Road/ Street	Location
Hawkesbury Road	Between Darcy Road and Hainsworth Street.
Hainsworth Street	Between Hawkesbury Road and Bridge Road.
Factory Street	Between New Street and Church Street.
Church Street	Between Factory Street and Victoria Road.
Macquarie Street	Between Church Street and Harris Street.
George Street	Between Alfred Street and Noller Parade.

What will this mean for you?

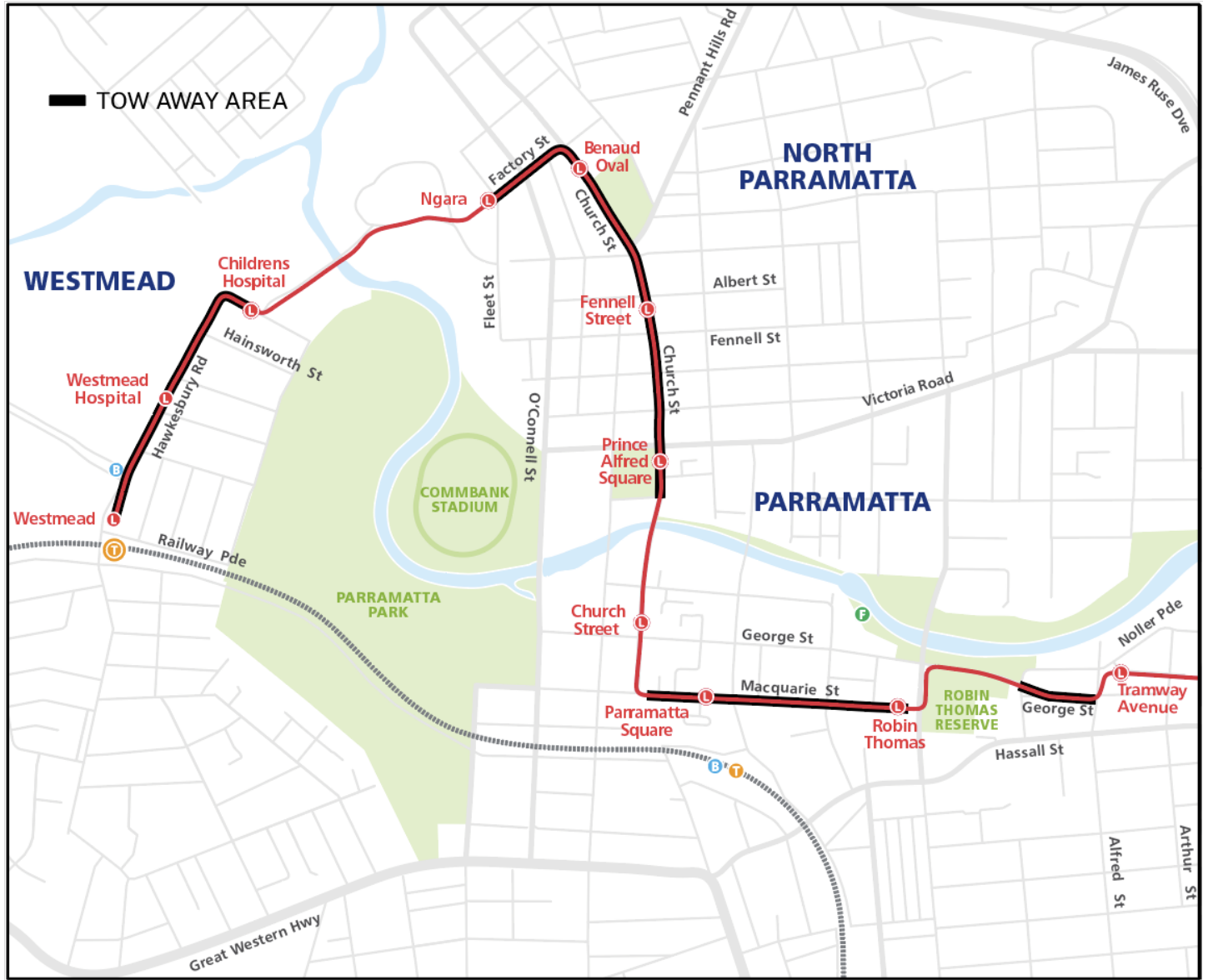
Special tow away areas allow any unattended vehicles that are illegally parked to be removed, by exercising powers under Section 143 of the Roads Transport Act 2013.
