



Pacific Motorway - Hexham

The M1 Pacific Motorway at Beresfield and the Pacific Highway at Hexham are linked via John Renshaw Drive and the New England Highway, forming a major north-south route. Hexham is one of four known pinch points for drivers heading from Sydney to Queensland.

Significant improvements have been made on the M1 Pacific Motorway and New England Highway since last summer, with noticeable changes in traffic flow.

Speed limits remain reduced over the holiday period, even when work is paused. This is for your safety, as conditions may include; narrow lanes, changed lane merges and altered traffic configurations.

Projects include Hexham Straight Widening, M1 Pacific Motorway to Raymond Terrace, and Rankin Park to Jesmond.
