Part 1 Preliminary

1 Name of Notification

This notification is the *Fisheries Management (Upper Winburndale Rivulet Sub-catchment Fishing Closure) Notification 2024*.

2 Commencement and duration

This notification commences on 16 January 2024 and will remain in force for three months.

Note: This notification is urgent and pursuant to section 9(2) and (3) of the Fisheries Management Act 1994, this notification will be published in the NSW Government Gazette as soon as practicable after publication on the Regional NSW and the NSW Department of Primary Industries' websites.

3 Definitions

In this notification:

Part 2 Fishing closure

4 Fishing closure

- (1) Pursuant to section 8 of the Act, a person is prohibited from taking fish by any method, in the following waters located to the northeast of Bathurst:
 - (a) the Gulf Stream,
 - (b) the Winburndale Rivulet and its tributaries, (Mitchells Creek, Lagoon Creek, McCanns Gully, Kirkconnell Creek, Bull Gully, Scotts Creek, Bobs Creek, Tindales Flat Creek, Roundbody Gully and Black Spring Gully), upstream of, and including Winburndale Dam, and
 - (c) the section of the Winburndale Rivulet from the Winburndale Dam wall at 33.38972222°S 149.77694444°E to 800 metres downstream from that dam wall at 33.38916667°S 149.76833333°E.
