Wash
The operator of a vessel must not cause wash that damages or impacts unreasonably on:

- Any dredge or floating plant.
- Any construction or other works in progress.
- Any bank, shore or waterside structure.
- Any other vessel, including a vessel that is moored.

NOTE: Penalties apply

No Wash signs
"Wash" is the wave effect created by a vessel moving through the water. No Wash signs are placed in some areas where the wash from a vessel is likely to cause damage to the foreshore or vessels, or injury or annoyance to people.

NO WASH ZONE
Travel at a speed which creates minimal wash when you see this sign and when near moored or anchored vessels. Look behind occasionally to see if your boat is creating wash that affects other boats or the shore. Adjust your speed if necessary.

Regardless of signs, you should not navigate your vessel in such a way as to produce excessive wash that endangers other vessels or impacts unreasonably, as this is an offence.

NOTE: Travelling at the speed shown on a speed restriction sign does not guarantee you are not creating wash.

Fees for use may be charged at launching ramps in this area

Caution: The river upstream from the road bridge is shallow and is generally only navigable at high tide.
Warning: A Personal Water Craft exclusion zone is in force in this area. Check signage at local launching ramps for latest details.

Note: Global Positioning System checkpoint as shown by GPS* is in WGS.84 co-ordinates to an accuracy of +/- 5 metres.
Equipment should be checked against this point to determine any gross errors prior to any seaward journey. Depending on equipment, errors of up to 100 metres is not uncommon.

Caution: Shallow waters (less than 2 metres deep) can contain seagrass and other sensitive fish habitats, which are at risk of damage from boat propellers.
Please exercise care when navigating or anchoring in shallow waters and avoid damaging or disturbing seagrass beds.
