


Land contour interval 20 metres. All heights and depths shown on this map refer to Australian Height Datum.

Water Ski Hand Signals

- 1 Speed Up** (Thumbs up)
- 2 Slow Down** (Thumbs down)
- 3 Turn** (Circling motion above head followed by pointing in the direction of the turn)
- 4 Back To Shore** (Pat top of head)
- 5 Cut Motor** (Slashing hand across throat)
- 6 OK After Fall** (Hands clasped over the head)
- 7 Stop** (Hands raised with fingers outstretched)
- 8 All OK** (An 'O' made with the thumb and index finger)



Note: The majority of foreshore lands around Pindari Dam are privately owned and permission is required to step ashore.
WARNING: BEWARE OF SUBMERGED ROCKS, TIMBER AND SHALLOW AREAS, PARTICULARLY AT LOWER LEVELS.

HYPOTHERMIA
Exposure to cold water can be fatal, especially after capsize or falling overboard. Be cautious, dress appropriately (avoid waders, they are hard to swim in) and know the limits of your craft.

Concrete faced rockfill construction
Original Dam constructed 1969.
Wall raised by 40 metres in 1995.
Increasing capacity from 37,500 mL to 312,000 megalitres at F.S.L.
Height 85m.
Crest Length 954m.

PINDARI DAM STORAGE LEVELS
Full Supply Level - 516 m Aust. Height Datum
75 percent - 507.8 m. AHD
50 percent - 497.6 m. AHD
25 percent - 483.5 m. AHD = Old Dam FSL.
