

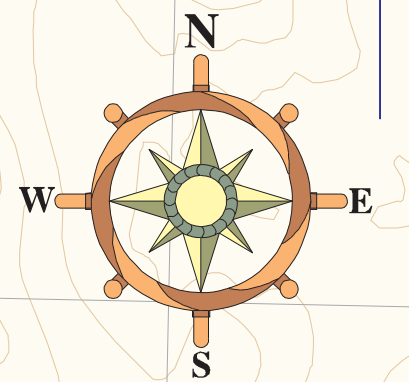
**WARNING**

Be alert to:

**HYPOTHERMIA**

Exposure to cold water can be fatal, especially after capsizing or falling overboard. Be cautious, dress appropriately (avoid waders, they are hard to swim in) and know the limits of your craft.
