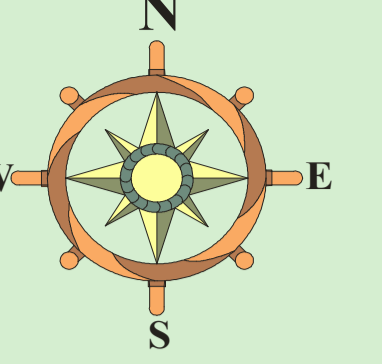

Caution: There are over 200 Club and Private Moorings in this area. RMS provide courtesy moorings coloured pink and are available for 24 hours and ONE vessel only. All other areas of Cowan Creek are controlled by the National Parks and Wildlife Service who provide visitor moorings coloured yellow.
