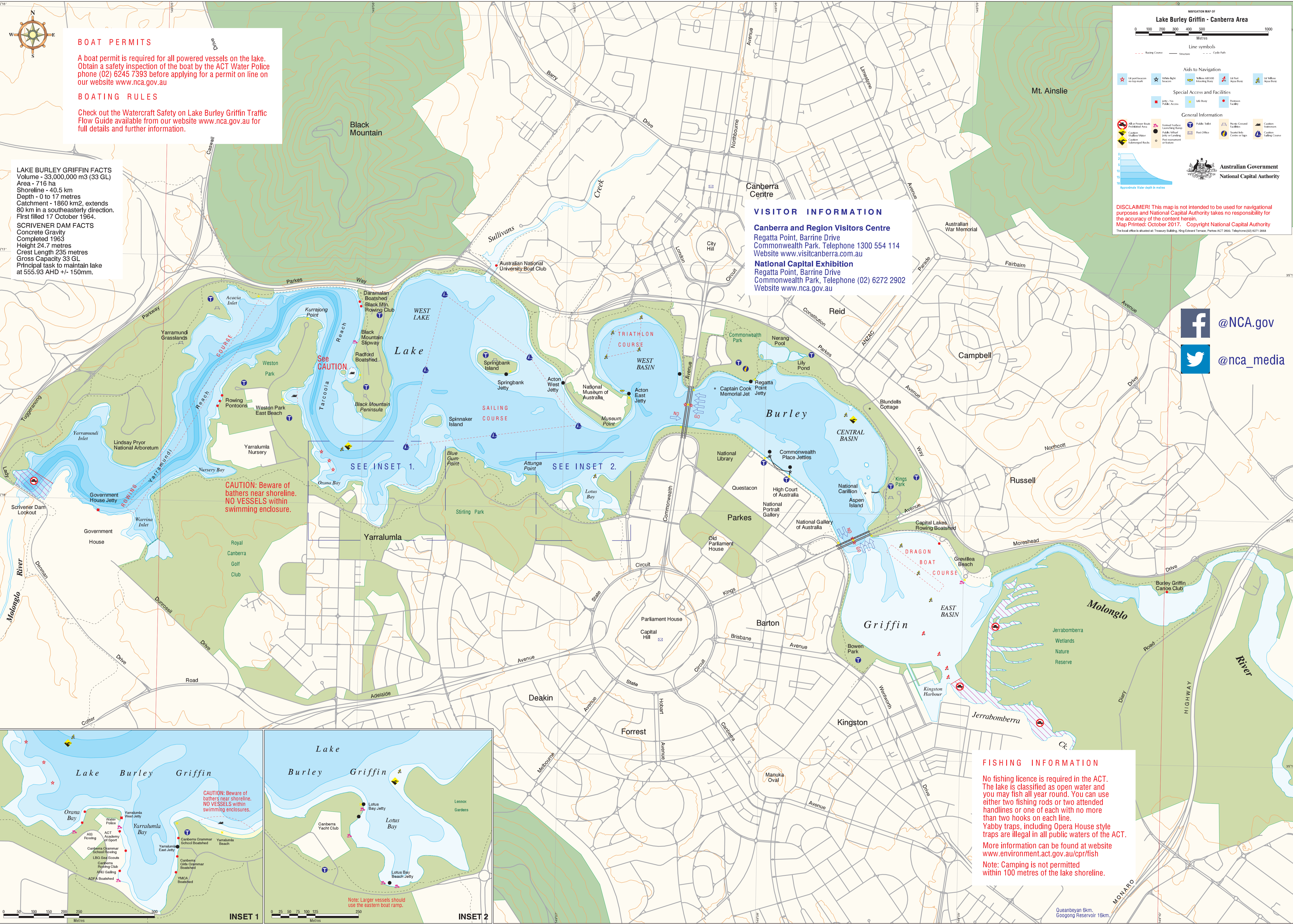

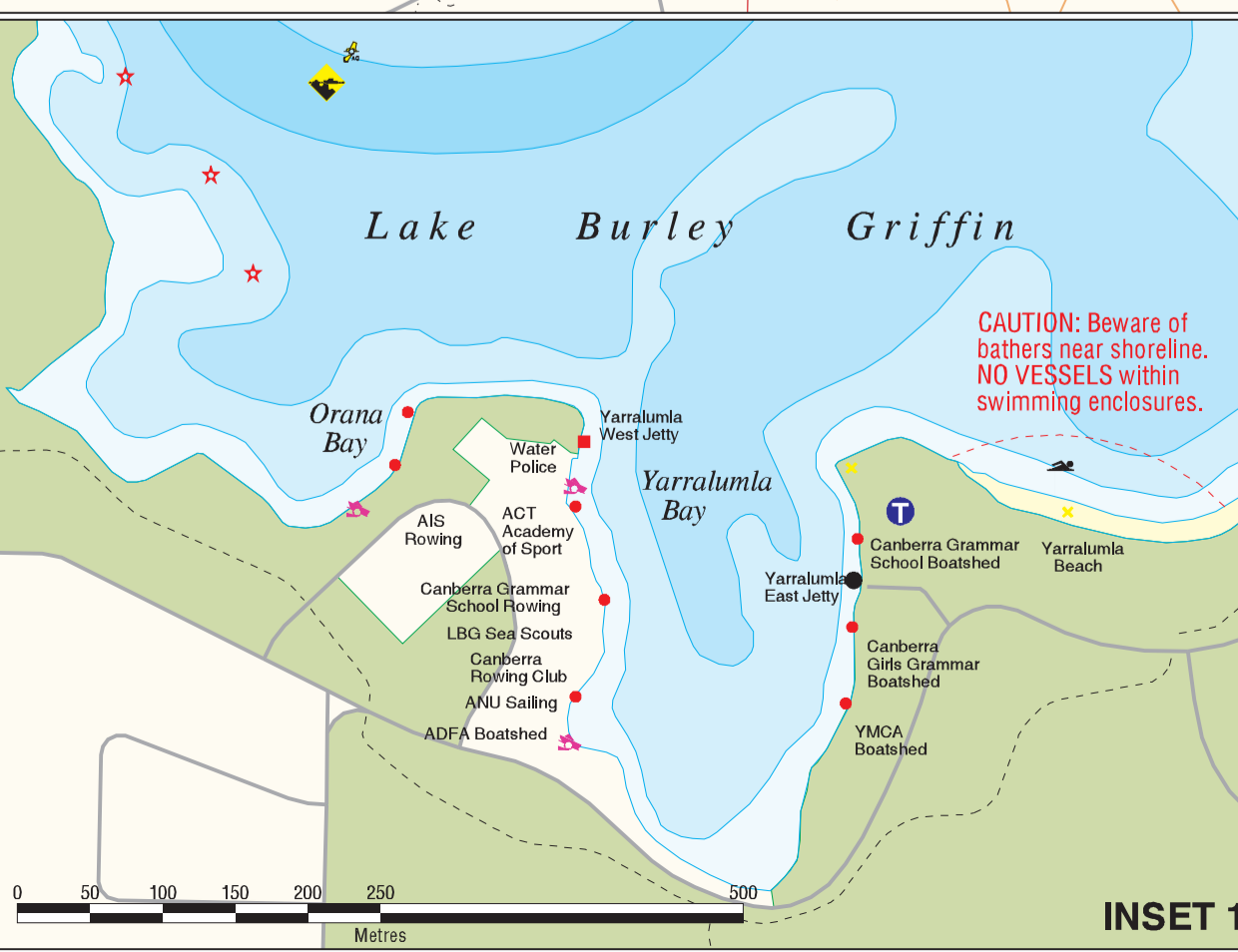

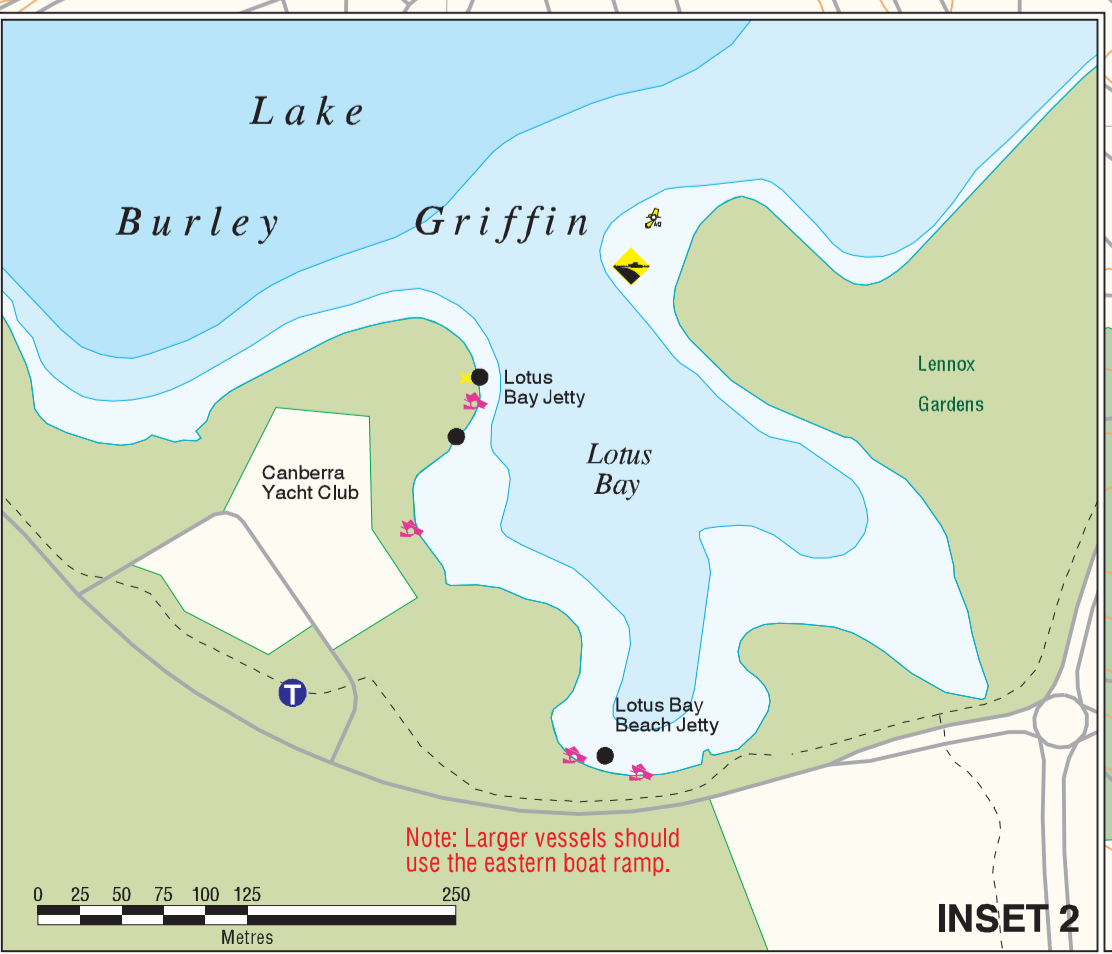

FISHING INFORMATION

No fishing licence is required in the ACT. The lake is classified as open water and you may fish all year round. You can use either two fishing rods or two attended handlines or one of each with no more than two hooks on each line. Yabby traps, including Opera House style traps are illegal in all public waters of the ACT. More information can be found at website www.environment.act.gov.au/cpr/fish
Note: Camping is not permitted within 100 metres of the lake shoreline.
