## Introduction

- The NRRC Advisory Board met on 27 October 2022. Apologies were received from Sharon Cadwallader and Gary Barnes.

## Resilient Land Program deep dive

- A focused overview of the Resilient Land Program was delivered, including an update on the Landholder Expression of Interest that is currently open to identify available private land.
- The Board discussed the importance of identifying quick-wins and developing a pipeline of fast-tracked land supply suitable for housing to create a resilient and adaptable region.

## Resilient Homes Program update

- An update was provided on the Resilient Homes Program prior to its upcoming launch, noting program guidelines, launch collateral and customer outreach methodology had been developed.
- An overview of stakeholder engagement under the program was provided, including information on events planned to commence in the week following announcement and eligible homeowner outreach from November onwards.
