TRADE AND INVESTMENT MISSION TO SINGAPORE AND MALAYSIA BY THE HONOURABLE STUART AYERS NSW MINISTER FOR TRADE, TOURISM, MAJOR EVENTS AND MINISTER FOR SPORT 29 NOVEMBER- 4 DECEMBER 2015 POST MISSION REPORT

MISSION PURPOSE

Both Singapore and Malaysia are NSW Government priority markets and have potential for continued growth in two way trade. Consistent with the *NSW International Engagement Strategy* (2013), the Minister's Mission to Singapore and Malaysia aimed to:

- Advance trade with priority ASEAN markets in sectors including fin-tech, education and infrastructure
- Attract investment into NSW from sovereign wealth funds and state-owned enterprises and high net worth individuals and companies
- Promote tourism to NSW from the ASEAN region
- Develop a stronger government-to-government relationship at a senior level with the governments of Malaysia and Singapore.

MISSION DESCRIPTION

Minister Ayres visited two cities, Singapore and Kuala Lumpur, over four days to promote trade and investment opportunities between NSW and Singapore and Malaysia.

MISSION BACKGROUND

The NSW International Engagement Strategy (2013) identifies 10 priority markets and aims to have high level visits to each of these markets each year to promote trade and investment. The Mission undertaken by the Minister included two priority markets, Malaysia and Singapore.

Regular engagement is central to the continued fostering of strong economic relationships with key markets. While both markets are strong bilateral trading partners with NSW, there is potential for enhancement of these trading relationships.

Singapore

The Minister for Trade visited Singapore on 30 November and 1 December to progress the NSW-Singapore government to government relationship and trade and investment at the highest level; to promote tourism to NSW and to observe best practice in sporting facility construction and operations.

While in Singapore, the Minister for Trade, Tourism, Major Events and Minister for Sport:

- met with Mr S Iswaran, The Singaporean Minister for Trade and Industry to progress discussions on sectors for collaboration and the compatibility of NSW and Singapore's corporate cultures.
- announced a two-year partnership between Destination NSW and Scoot Airlines by entering into a Memorandum of Understanding to increase Singaporean tourism to Sydney and NSW.

- undertook a visit to the Singapore Sports Hub to examine the operations of this state-of-the-art multi-function facility.
- met with key investors including Singaporean urban redevelopers.
- attended a fin-tech investor roundtable hosted by Austrade to promote NSW's investment pipeline with targeted institutional Singaporean investors with a demonstrated interest in investments in NSW.

Malaysia

The Minister for Trade visited Kuala Lumpur on 2 and 3 December to progress the NSW-Malaysia government to government relationship and trade and investment at the highest level; to promote tourism to NSW; to promote NSW's educational capacity and to engage in business meetings and core business events.

While in Kuala Lumpur, the Minister for Trade, Tourism, Major Events and Minister for Sport:

- met the Malaysian Minister for International Trade and Industry, Dato' Sri Mustapa Mohamed to progress discussions on opportunities arising from the Malaysian-Australia Free Trade Agreement (MAFTA) and the Trans Pacific Partnership (TPP) and to pursue opportunities arising from the establishment of the ASEAN Economic Community.
- conducted an education roundtable discussion with major universities representatives, alumni
 councils and education agents to promote NSW's educational capacity and Malaysia's need to
 enhance workforce skills and capabilities.
- Attended a business roundtable with senior business leaders to discuss Malaysia's key industry sectors of growth, to profile the strength of the NSW economy and promote NSW's capacity across the service industry.
- promoted tourism to NSW to airline partners and senior management from key travel agents.
- Undertook a site inspection and met with executives of the TRX Lifestyle Quarter, the largest urban redevelopment and regeneration construction project in Malaysia being jointly developed with Australian construction expertise by Lend Lease and Malaysia's IMDB Real Estate.
- promoted the opportunities in NSW to targeted Malaysian investors at a dinner hosted by the Australian High Commission,

KEY OUTCOMES

1. Further developed the NSW – Singapore and NSW – Malaysia relationships

The Premier met with senior government leaders including the Singaporean Minister for Trade and Industry and the Malaysian Minister for International Trade and Industry.

In **Singapore**, NSW will work with the Singapore to further explore areas for collaboration in the services sector.

In **Malaysia**, NSW will collaborate with Malaysia on assisting companies to maximise opportunities arising from MAFTA and the TPP.

2. Promote the NSW services sector

The Minister promoted NSW capability in the sectors financial tech, med tech and aged care sector.

3. Attract Singaporean and Malaysian investment

Follow up opportunities following the investor roundtables held in Singapore and Malaysia.

4. Increase the value of Singaporean tourism to NSW

The Minister signed a two-year partnership agreement with low cost carrier Scoot which will include multiple marketing campaigns to increase inbound tourism from Singapore to Sydney and NSW.

5. Promote NSW Education

Share learnings on Malaysian tertiary and vocational education and training needs to increase the NSW educational presence in Malaysia.
