TRADE, INVESTMENT AND TRANSPORT MISSION TO SINGAPORE, HONG KONG, CHINA AND JAPAN BY

THE HON ANDREW CONSTANCE MP MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND INFRASTRUCTURE 4-14 July 2016 POST MISSION REPORT

MISSION PURPOSE

The Hon Andrew Constance MP, Minister for Transport and Infrastructure travelled to Singapore, Hong Kong, China and Japan to promote current and future infrastructure pipelines and investment opportunities in NSW, and experience world class transport systems and their operations. The key objectives and outcomes for the mission were to:

- Ensure New South Wales remains at the forefront of transport delivery by engaging with industry leaders to enable Transport for NSW to become a world leader in applying technology to deliver better transport outcomes.
- Provide an opportunity to promote NSW's ambitious infrastructure investment program and build international relationships to proactively position NSW as a prime location for business growth and investment, in major transport infrastructure
- Gather learning from the region with a particular focus on transport and infrastructure delivery and operations.
- Strengthen government to government relationships.

MISSION DESCRIPTION

The NSW Transport and Infrastructure Minister visited Singapore, Hong Kong, Shanghai and Tokyo over 10 days.

MISSION BACKGROUND

The NSW Government International Engagement Strategy (2013) identifies priority markets and aims to have high level missions to these markets to promote trade and investment. ASEAN (including Singapore), China and Japan are priority markets under the strategy. The mission involved the Minister visiting cities where complex integrated transport solutions have been successfully deployed. There was a strong focus on promoting New South Wales' infrastructure investment program and establish relationships with key infrastructure industry representatives and investors. The mission also aligns with Transport for NSW objectives in the areas of:

- metro rail, light rail and high speed rail:
 - to inform delivery of Sydney Light Rail, Sydney Metro, Newcastle Light Rail,
 Parramatta Light Rail and public transport in the Badgerys Creek precinct;
 - to inform discussions on proposed high speed rail routes.
- transport interchanges and complex multi-modal integration, including airport and land transport interaction:
 - o to inform full integration of the land transport network;
 - o to reveal new and innovative ways to ensure public transport on-time running;
 - o to inform congestion mitigation strategies around airport precincts.
- integrated ticketing and fare technology:

- o to reveal innovations and incentives that optimise the customer experience;
- to build on momentum from the NSW Government Future Transport Summit to transform service and product offerings.

SINGAPORE

The Minister for Transport and Infrastructure visited Singapore on 4 July and 5 July to progress the NSW-Singapore government to government relationship and investment prospects and to investigate opportunities to improve technology utilisation and operational processes in NSW transport and infrastructure.

While in Singapore, the Minister for Transport and Infrastructure:

- Visited the Changi East Airport construction to view the project scope, consider land use and transport implications, and understand learnings for proposed NSW developments
- Met with Ms Josephine Teo, Minister for Foreign Affairs and Transport in Singapore to strengthen the NSW-Singapore relationship and to understand the management of transport operations
- Met with the Land Transport Authority to review metro rail operations, congestion management, autonomous vehicles and land value capture
- Visited the SBS Transit depot to discuss operational activities and view the fully automated Operational Control Centre
- Chaired an investor roundtable hosted by Austrade to promote NSW's investment pipeline with Singaporean investors with a demonstrated interest in diversified investments in NSW

HONG KONG

The Minister for Transport and Infrastructure visited Hong Kong on 5 July to 7 July to progress the NSW-Hong Kong government to government relationship and investment prospects and to investigate opportunities to improve technology utilisation and operational processes in NSW transport and infrastructure.

While in Hong Kong, the Minister for Transport and Infrastructure:

- Met with Ms Ingrid Yeung, Commissioner for Transport to understand the management of transport operations and understand value capture mechanisms utilised in Hong Kong
- Chaired an investor roundtable to promote NSW's investment pipeline with Hong Kong investors with a demonstrated interest in diversified investments in NSW
- Met with Mass Transit Rail (MTR) Corporation to discuss complex multi-modal transport integration, advanced value capture strategies, integrated ticketing and fare integration
- Visited Wong Chuk Hang Depot to discuss and experience fully automated operation trains
- Visited Admiralty Station to observe passenger flow and crowd management at one of Hong Kong's busiest metro rail stations during the evening peak
- Visited Kowloon Station to experience and view transport interchanges and complex multi-modal integration
- Visited Tsingyi Operational Control to observe the functioning of the Operational Control Centre for the MTR rail network

CHINA

The Minister for Transport and Infrastructure visited Shanghai on 7 July to 9 July to progress the NSW-China government to government relationship and investment prospects and to investigate opportunities to improve technology utilisation and operational processes in NSW transport and infrastructure.

While in China, the Minister for Transport and Infrastructure:

- Met with the Australian China Chamber of Commerce
- Met with the Shanghai Municipal Transport Commissioner to understand the management of transport operations and discuss transport innovations being undertaken in Shanghai
- Chaired an investor roundtable to promote NSW's investment pipeline with Chinese investors with a demonstrated interest in diversified investments in NSW
- Visited Hong Qiao Logistics Hub to observe the world's largest multi-modal transportation hub connecting an international airport, high-speed and inter-city rail, metro system and public ground transportation systems, and the arterial road network and expressways.
- Visited Shanghai Yangtze River tunnel and bridge to observe fully operational monitoring and alert systems for traffic flow and management
- Experienced high speed rail (bullet train) and maglev rail technology.

JAPAN

The Minister for Transport and Infrastructure visited Tokyo on 9 July to 13 July to progress the NSW-Japan government to government relationship and investment prospects and to investigate opportunities to improve technology utilisation and operational processes in NSW transport and infrastructure.

While in Japan, the Minister for Transport and Infrastructure:

- Met with JR Central to discuss and experience high speed rail, above ground station development and operational processes
- Met with Mr Masafumi Shukuri, Chairman for International High-Speed Railway Association to discuss high speed rail opportunities
- Met with Tokyo Metro to observe and discuss rail operations and high speed rail
- Chaired an investor roundtable to promote NSW's investment pipeline with Japanese investors with a demonstrated interest in diversified investments in NSW
- Met with Mr Hideki Miyauchi, Parliamentary Vice-Minister of Lands, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism to strengthen the NSW-Japan relationship and understand the management of transport operations

KEY OUTCOMES

The mission promoted current and future infrastructure pipelines and investment opportunities in NSW and provided the opportunity to experience world class transport systems, and their operations, to inform future NSW Government investment in major transport infrastructure.

Showcased NSW's ambitious infrastructure pipeline and generated interest in investment opportunities

The mission drew investor's attention to key NSW sectors, in particular transport and infrastructure. The Minister promoted NSW as an attractive investment environment and discussed the pipeline of infrastructure projects with potential investors and reinforced the strong NSW economy. There was significant interest from business leaders in current NSW infrastructure projects.

Innovation and Technology

The mission provided a unique opportunity to see firsthand the world class transport systems in Asia. These learnings are of benefit to NSW as there are opportunities to expand technology utilisation in NSW public transport and infrastructure to improve customer service and satisfaction and to ensure Transport for NSW remains agile and innovative. Learning about Asia's operational processes used to support complex integrated transport solutions was also a key outcome from the mission.

Airport - rail infrastructure connectivity

The mission provided an opportunity to better understand how major cities link their airport and rail infrastructure to promote economic growth and productivity, including planning considerations, funding models and the use of different transport modes to achieve optimal transport outcomes.
