#### PURPOSE OF TRAVEL

To attend the 2017 LinCT Counter Terrorism Conference in New York, hosted by the New York City Police Department and the Leadership in Counter Terrorism Alumni Association for the period 25 April to 1 May 2017 inclusive.

Corrective Services NSW Peter Severin and Chief of Staff (COS) Katherine Danks accompanied Minister Elliott.

#### BENEFITS OF TRAVEL FOR THE STATE OF NEW SOUTH WALES

The conference provided an opportunity to share understanding of counter terrorism and countering violent extremism policy challenges. This included helpful developments and programs jurisdictions have in preventing violent extremism, jurisdictional developments in overcoming barriers to reporting extremism, successful strategies to coordinate effort and share information between relevant law enforcement, intelligence and support agencies, as well as an update on the global threat environment and how it is evolving.

#### **KEY OUTCOMES/ FINDINGS**

Minister Elliott briefed Cabinet on confidential key findings and lessons from the conference and sideline meetings. 'Chatham House' rules applied to all sessions of the conference. However, key findings are that the threat of terrorism will continue to be a problem for all governments for at least a generation, it is not a unique challenge to Australia, and the NSW Government's programs and policies align with best practice. However, there is no silver bullet and information sharing remains key to addressing this emerging and evolving threat.
