PURPOSE OF TRAVEL

To attend the 2017 Premier's Anzac Ambassadors Program in Israel from 28 October, 2017 to Monday, 6 November 2017 inclusive for the commemoration of the centenary of the Charge of the Fourth Light Horse Brigade at Beersheba. The program is funded by ClubsNSW.

Minister Elliott was accompanied by his Deputy Chief of Staff (COS)/ Senior Policy Adviser.

BENEFITS OF TRAVEL FOR THE STATE OF NEW SOUTH WALES

The program, funded by ClubsNSW, will take six students to retrace to footsteps of the Anzacs and visit historic battlefields in Greece and Israel. It intends to further develop the education of our young people and encourage them to enhance their appreciation of the sacrifice of our servicemen and women.

Students will travel from the 24 October to 5 November, accompanied by ClubsNSW CEO Anthony Ball, Eleni Petinos MP, Member for Miranda, Stephen Kamper MP, Member for Rockdale, Shelley Hancock, Member for South Coast and Speaker of the NSW Legislative Assembly, and Gareth Ward, Member for Kiama and Parliamentary Secretary for Education and the Illawarra. Minister Elliott will join the delegation when they arrive in Tel Aviv following their activities in Greece.

In Israel, the Minister will represent the Premier at the commemoration of the 100th Anniversary of the Light Horse Charge at Beersheba. Attending the Premier's Anzac Ambassadors Program will complement the Minister's role in ensuring our veterans are honoured with dignity and respect.

This travel will also provide the Minister an opportunity partake in strategic Counter Terrorism meetings in his role as Minister for Counter Terrorism.
