# Mission to the United States of America by The Honourable Gladys Berejiklian MP Premier of New South Wales 21-26 February 2018 Mission Report

#### **PURPOSE OF TRAVEL**

The NSW Premier undertook a mission to the United States of America (US) from 21 to 26 February 2018 to achieve the following objectives:

- Attend the US National Governors Association (NGA) 2018 Winter Session, at the
  invitation of the Honourable Joe Hockey, Australia's Ambassador to the US as part of
  a Commonwealth Government-led whole of Australia initiative. The Prime Minister of
  Australia; Premiers of Victoria, Queensland and Western Australia; and the Chief
  Ministers of the Australian Capital Territory and Northern Territory also attended.
- Address more than 40 US Governors on the success of asset recycling in NSW at a special joint session of the NGA.
- Attract international investment into NSW and generate interest in the NSW Government's significant infrastructure pipeline and the Western Sydney airport precinct.
- Grow NSW's relationship and business partnerships with senior US and Australian business leaders.
- Reinforce the importance of the US-NSW relationship.

#### BENEFITS OF TRAVEL FOR THE STATE OF NEW SOUTH WALES

International missions by the Premier are a critical part of the NSW Government's efforts to promote trade and investment. International trade and investment account for a significant portion of the NSW economy, supporting jobs in metropolitan and regional NSW.

The US is a priority market for NSW trade and investment. It is NSW's third largest merchandise trading partner and second largest source of tourists (2016-17 financial year).

The Premier's participation ensured NSW was represented at the highest level alongside the Prime Minister of Australia, the Premiers and Chief Ministers of five other Australian states and territories, and a senior delegation of Australian business leaders. This was reported to be the largest and most significant delegation of Australian government officials and business leaders ever to visit the US.

#### **KEY MISSION OUTCOMES**

#### Washington DC - 22 to 25 February 2018

Sought learnings from the challenges and opportunities facing state governments in the US

The key themes of the NGA 2018 Winter Session were economic development, health, education, innovation and energy, agriculture and veterans services. Australia was the exclusive international partner and had the largest international presence at the event.

The Premier and the Premier's official delegation heard from US Governors during the NGA open plenary sessions, and in separate meetings with US business representatives, to gain insight into US infrastructure plans, and approaches to energy and transport innovation. US counterparts sought NSW learnings in asset recycling and innovative financial management.

#### Showcased NSW success in asset recycling

The Premier addressed guests and participated in a Q&A at a luncheon hosted by the United States Studies Centre with Ms Lucy Turnbull AO, Chief Commissioner of the Greater Sydney Commission. The focus of the lunch presentation was promoting NSW's investment in infrastructure and the integration of planning into the effective delivery of that infrastructure.

At a special joint international session of the NGA, the Premier addressed approximately 40 US Governors on NSW strengths in asset recycling and infrastructure. The Premier's delegation also shared NSW learnings in this area in separate business meetings with US representatives.

## Strengthened bilateral relationships

The Premier met with US Governors at a series of Embassy and NGA hosted events. The Premier built on existing relationships and encouraged the Governors of Kentucky, South Dakota and Maryland to consider opportunities for collaboration and knowledge exchange with NSW.

Supported stronger business partnerships and promoted investment opportunities in NSW

The Premier joined the Prime Minister of Australia and fellow Premiers and Chief Ministers to meet with senior business leaders from the US and Australia at a boardroom meeting and Joint Forum coordinated by the Australian Embassy. The Premier promoted investment opportunities in NSW, particularly in Western Sydney, and the strength of the NSW economy to the senior business leaders from both countries. As a group, they addressed trade, economic growth, defence and innovation issues and ways to enhance business and government ties between Australia and the US.

The Premier met with senior representatives of Boeing International to promote the Western Sydney Aerotropolis as a destination for investment and to recognise Boeing's existing presence in NSW. The Premier also met with the President of General Dynamics Mission Systems to promote opportunities for investment in the Western Sydney Aerotropolis.

The Premier attended a dinner hosted by the Business Council of Australia and the Business Council for International Understanding with senior business leaders from the US and Australia. The event explored key policy issues facing the US, economic and trade opportunities, and geopolitics in the Asia Pacific Region.
